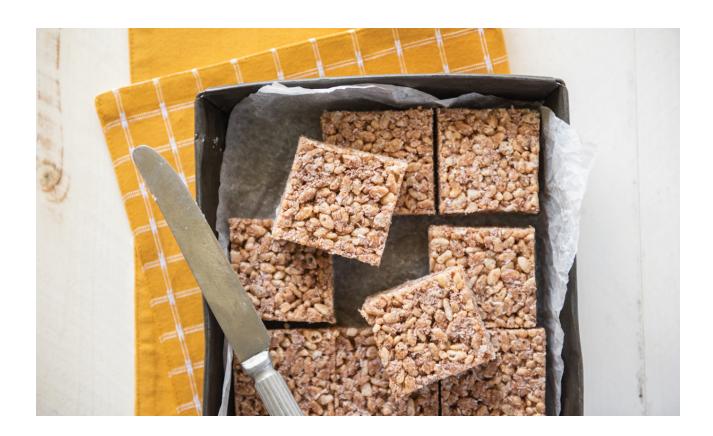


# Choc Honey Crackle Slice

# **Ingredients**

- 180g (½ cup) Capilano Pure Honey

## Method

- 1. Line a square cake or slice pan with baking paper. Place honey, cocoa powder and butter in a saucepan and cook, stirring, over a low heat until butter and choc honey spread is melted and well combined.
